Michaela Jones

Music Director of Joondalup Symphony Orchestra

An accomplished musician and conductor, Michaela has been Concertmaster of The Hills Symphony Orchestra, guest performer for several bands across Australia, and string teacher at numerous prestigious schools throughout Perth. Michaela first became interested in conducting in 2010, but truly embraced her passion for conducting in 2021 when she became co-founder and Music Director of Joondalup Symphony Orchestra. Michaela's dedication as the JSO Music Director over the past 20 months, has seen JSO perform eight sell-out shows with audiences of up to 800 people, as well as ensemble performances on the main stage at the Perth Royal Show in 2021, the City of Wanneroo's Christmas Festival in 2022, and a performance at the City of Wanneroo's Symphony Under the Stars in 2023. Michaela was also selected for Perth Symphony Orchestra's 'Women on the Podium' program, working with world-renowned conductors such as Alice Farnham, Sarah-Grace Williams, Jessica Gethin and Peter Moore.





Lisa Robertson

Co-Music Director of JSO Intermezzo

Growing up in Queensland, Lisa was involved in many musical groups, such as orchestras, string ensembles, brass bands, and stage bands, playing both the violin and trombone to a high standard. These provided many opportunities to perform locally, interstate and internationally, most notably performing throughout South-east Asia and the Torres Strait Islands with the Queensland Youth Orchestra. As an adult, Lisa taught violin in the Joondalup area for several years, before taking a break to bring up her children. More recently, Lisa became a co-founder of Joondalup Symphony Orchestra and Co-Music Director of JSO Intermezzo, encouraging emerging and returning musicians to reach their potential in an orchestral setting. Lisa has co-directed Intermezzo since its foundation in August 2021 and looks forward to continuing to support and nurture musicians to reach their fullest potential.

Christina is an advocate for music education, music as a social medium to connect people, and music for respite. She completed a Bachelor of Music/Bachelor of Education in 2010 at Queensland University of Technology, specialising in Classical, Musical Theatre and Jazz voice. Christina has performed with choirs across Australia and conducted many school orchestras and bands. After teaching classroom music for 12 years, Christina now works in community engagement for the West Australian Symphony Orchestra, taking musicians into areas of the community that otherwise wouldn't have the accessibility to see live music in Perth Concert Hall. Christina has co-directed Intermezzo since its foundation in 2021.

Mia has also written and performed in a solo cabaret 'Mia Myself and I' at the Round House Theatre at WAAPA in 2022 and has written two other short musical shows under the tutelage of screen writer/director and 'Performing Arts WA Awards' winner, Tyler Jacob Jones and internationally celebrated musical director/composer and educator at WAAPA, Joe Louis Robinson.

At 14, Sarah performed a solo for Pope Benedict XVI and an audience of 5,000 in Sydney. Sarah remained mostly silent for the next decade but the pandemic provided a chance for reflection and she rekindled her passion for singing.

In 2020, Sarah was chosen to be perform on 'Treeson: An Eco-Musical', with songs by US composer and lyricist Victoria Campbell, Ph.D. and arrangements by West End composer Joseph Purdue.

In November 2022 Sarah sang at the "Women For The World" luncheon and fundraiser in Darling Harbour for Caritas Australia, helping to raise \$104,000 towards education and healthcare for females around the globe experiencing extreme poverty, inequality and discrimination.
